# **CMARC** logo

The proposed CMARC logo designs were extensively discussed. Ultimately, the board, with considerable input from many sources, settled on a fairly simple design with a tower graphic with radiation circles superimposed on an outline of the lower peninsula of the State of Michigan. The circular text "CENTRAL MICHIGAN AMATEUR RADIO CLUB" was maintained and surrounds the graphic. Included within the circular text are the club's call signs (W8PLP, W8MAA) and "Est 1921". Gordy Smith KE8JKS worked with a graphics designer who provided electronic logo files. The black and white logo (and its negative) were agreed on, but what color to use to fill in the state outline was only roughly agreed on. Most felt a medium blue would be best. Chad Lyke KE8YHZ mentioned we can fill with any color later.

#### **CMARC** communications trailer

The CMARC Communications Trailer, now at Tom Rocheleau WA8WPI house, now has the air conditioner installed and working, thanks to the hard work by Tim Clay KC8THC, Gordy Smith KE8JKS, and Tom Rocheleau WA8WPI. Wood for the benches has been purchased but not yet installed.
